Schedule for Summer Staff:

Most of the summer staff arrive Tuesday evening, May 26, for an enjoyable and yet intense two-weeks of training. For those needing to arrive at a later date exceptions are sometimes possible. The last regular week ends Aug. 10 and our HIS-Ability week ends Aug. 15.

Schedule for Summer Campers:

Campers begin arriving June 9. Each Tuesday afternoon a new group arrives and they depart the following Monday morning. The staff take a break Monday and spend that evening and Tuesday morning relaxing, rejuvenating and worshiping in preparation for the next group of campers.

Finances:

Barakel has a long history of a real missionary spirit; no one (*not even the resident year 'round staff*) is paid a salary. Christ's great sacrifice fills us with passion to know Him and eagerness to serve. You'll find that every staff person has a story about God's leading to come to Barakel, and how God actively provides for them to be here.
