FEES... The cost for each of the two High School weeks is \$275, and all the other weeks cost \$250. A deposit of \$50 must accompany the registration form. The balance is due one week prior to arrival. If you are unable to attend your week of camp, the registration deposit is refundable if we are notified no less than two weeks prior to the Tuesday your week begins.

- Registrations are taken individually, not by group. All housing arrangements and assignments are made after the campers arrive. If your child wants to be housed with one or two friends, they simply stand together when cabin groups ("tribes") are formed.
